100th Anniversary of the Death of Venerable Mary Theresa Dudzik

In honor of the 100th death anniversary of Mother Theresa which occurred on September 20, 2018, Rev. Tom Bernas celebrated Mass at Our Lady of Victory Motherhouse in Lemont, IL. The Mass was preceded by a special Morning Praise commemorating Venerable Theresa Dudzik as the Foundress of the Franciscan Sisters of Chicago. A large oil painted portrait of Mother Theresa surrounded by fresh flowers reminded all of the cause of the festivity. After Mass the Sisters as well as the residents joined in lunch followed by a special sundae bar dessert to complete the celebration.

Masses for the Cause of Beatification for Venerable Theresa Dudzik were offered at 9 AM at Our Lady of Victory Motherhouse in Lemont, IL by Fr. Tom Bernas on the following dates:

These dates are scheduled for the third Saturday of each month so that those devoted to Mother Theresa's Cause can easily remember them and attend the Mass. The Sisters serve the participants a light brunch following the Mass.

On those same dates St. Stanislaus Kostka Parish in Chicago offers its 4pm Mass for the intention of promoting the Cause. At the conclusion of the Mass the entire congregation recites the Beatification Prayer.
